policy for absences & grades

* Unit tests will be announced and students will be given enough time to prepare for the tests. Students are responsible for keeping all study material on their i-pad or in their notebook and studying prior to the test. In addition, there will be short, unannounced quizzes throughout each unit to check for knowledge and understanding of the material.

*** If your student scores below a 70% on a test, then he/she will have the opportunity to re-test to bring their grade up to a 70%. The student MUST contact me within 3 days of notification of test grade. It is HIS/HER responsibility to contact me.**

* Family access in skyward will allow parent to regularly check student's progress.

* Tutorials will be provided once a week. If you need to schedule another day, then please see Mrs. Ivey to schedule a time.

* Your student has **THREE (3)** days to make up absent work. If a lab is missed they must attend tutorials to make it up.

Cell Phone Policy



Electronic devices should be kept in students backpacks. Devices should not be out during class, unless otherwise instructed by the teacher or with permission.
